This month I was told that Nick Hunt has hung up his bee suit for the last time and is now helping to manage the great apiary in the sky. Nick has been a long standing and much respected member (Since before John Holden joined GBK!) of Gwent Beekeepers Association. Our thoughts and prayers are with Nick's family.

We would like to begin monthly Apiary meeting sessions at the Holden Apiary. While COVID restrictions allow, we are bringing back the 2nd Sunday of the Month 'Members Apiary Sessions' starting in May, and going through to September.

Starting on Sunday 8th May, at 2.15pm the first session will be a 'meet and greet' at the Study Centre with plenty of tea/coffee and cake. This will give you the opportunity to see our new facility. We will also be setting up the microscope and having a demonstration of a Nosema analysis. If you'd like to bring a sample of about 30 bees from one of your hives, we can take you through the process of checking for Nosema in your colony. Directions to the Holden Apiary and Study Centre are on our website.

We will need a team of Apiary helpers, with hospitality skills and to coordinate the afternoon. If you would like to help for an hour (or longer) on the afternoon, then please email **contact@gwentbeekeepers.co.uk**.

Beekeeping Taster Sessions;

Last year we ran 8 two-hour taster sessions for members of the public to come and experience beekeeping. We talked about honeybees, the important of pollinators and then we took them down to the apiary in beekeeping suits. Here they got to see inside a working hive and many even got to handle frames of bees.



These sessions were fully subscribed to and it was good to meet many of the people who attended the taster sessions

later on in the New Beekeepers training course. For 2022, we are planning nine taster sessions split between Wednesdays and Saturdays.

In order for us to run these sessions, we rely on members giving up their time to help us run these. Thank you to everyone who helped in 2021 - please let us know if you are able to help again this year. We'll be publishing on the website the dates and times for the Taster Sessions this year.

New Beekeeper Training;

In Spring 2021 we ran the New Beekeepers Training Course for 28 "NewBees". These lectures were delivered over nine weeks via zoom and were followed up by weekly Apiary sessions on Tuesdays.

In June 2021 we tried something new and delivered intensive two day training courses over one weekend. Morning delivery with afternoon hands on practical work. Attendees were invited to join the beginners Tuesday evening apiary sessions. This format is used by several Associations but it is difficult to condense the BBKA eight-week training into two days. Trainees found the wealth of information overwhelming and it restricted the time that trainees had for background reading on the discussed areas.

It's a good introduction to Beekeeping, but not suitable for beginning beekeeping. In spite of our reservations, we had very good feedback on the course and its delivery, but we will be considering an alternative delivery this season.

The Spring 2022 "NewBees" training course is currently underway with 30 very keen trainees. We are offering dual access with face-to-face training at the Holden Study Centre or online via Zoom. This use of technology allows people who are isolating, work restricted, or unwell to still join us for the evening training. Attendance this year has been very good.
